1. West of England Joint Spatial Plan (JSP) Examination

Eight local people spoke at a recent B&NES Council meeting to put the case forward from the Village that the plans for 2500 dwellings on green belt land, included in the JSP, were not acceptable.

B&NES Council made a decision to withdraw from the JSP and to continue with a Local Plan. This does not mean the Village is now reprieved – but we have ensured that our views and voices have been heard and that we will scrutinise any plans that involve our Village and lives.

Once again a huge thank you to all those who have been involved with this.

2. Community Clean Up

We all like to see clean streets! For the past few years we have organised a Community Clean up once or twice a year. We would love to see some of you get involved. The next clean up being held, in conjunction with The Great British Spring Clean, is on Saturday 28th March from 10.00am – 12 noon.
