Allotment Vacancies

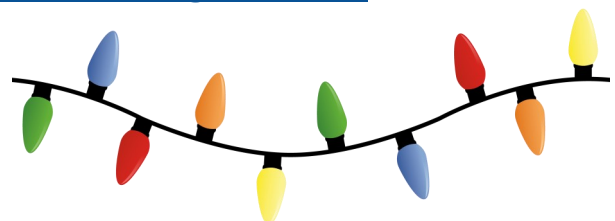

St. Nicholas Pre-School has been at the heart of Whitchurch Village for over 35 years. It is based in St. Nicholas Church Hall and prides itself on having a family focused environment.

The Pre-School is a sessional Pre-school which takes children from 2 years and 8 months for afternoon sessions – Monday, Wednesday and Friday 12.30-3pm and for children, in the year before they start school, we offer Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings 9-12 and all day Thursday 9-3.

St. Nics Pre-school staff also run weekly baby and toddler groups held in Whitchurch Community Centre. First Steps is for 0-2 year olds and is held on Thursday mornings 10-11.30; Little Learners is our group for 2-3 year olds which takes place on a Wednesday and Friday morning 9.30-11.15.
