The library is still proving a great success with new titles appearing every week.

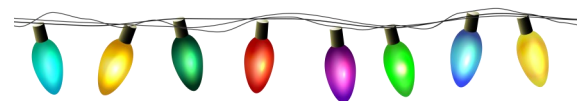
Please feel free to have a browse, borrow a book, donate a book and continuing enjoying this free amenity in the centre of the Village

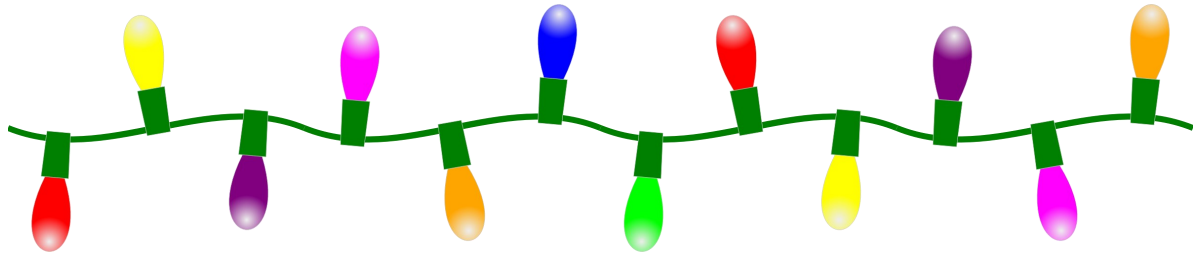
